

# 2024 Olentangy Summer Strings Camp

Strings Camp Parents/Guardians:

This is your official confirmation of enrollment in the Olentangy Summer Strings Camp for July 15-19, 2024. Your child has been placed in the ensemble that best meets their needs according to their registration information and teacher recommendation.

## FIRST DAY CHECK IN:

**On the first day please arrive by 8:45 AM.** Check In is at the Otterbein Campus Center. This is where you will find out your child's group assignment. Please fill out the enclosed forms ahead of time to expedite your check-in and bring them with you. When you arrive you can expect to do the following:

1. **Overnight campers drop luggage in the lobby of the dorms.** There will be staff there to meet you.
2. **Check in by last name.** Turn in your student's emergency medical forms and waivers and receive their group assignment. This is where your child will receive their large ensemble group assignment.
3. **Visit the help desk if needed.** If you have medicines, outstanding payments, or have questions, both camp administrators (Lori Cornett and Tiffany Bartelt) will be there.
4. **Find the counselor for your child's group.** The counselors will walk campers to their assigned group and introduce them to their group's director.

## DROP OFF/PICK UP:

**After the first day, you will drop off and pick up your student off directly at their assigned location listed below.**

We make every effort to dismiss students on time but please allow some flexibility in your schedule as we have a lot of students who will be packing up and exiting the buildings at the same time. Pick up locations will have a director assigned to them to ensure student safety.

## FRIDAY CONCERT

On Friday all campers will remain with us until 5:00 PM, at which time we will have a final concert for families and friends in the Amphitheater located in Alum Creek Park. Plan to bring your chairs or a blanket to sit on and try to sit only in the center section of the amphitheater. We will have some areas marked off for student seating and staff there to help. Students will be dismissed to their families following the concert, which usually lasts one hour. **Important:** We will communicate with you about alternate plans in the event of inclement weather.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Rules
  - While camp is designed to be fun and exciting, please remember that you will be guests on a large campus. Students are expected to follow the same rules at camp that they would follow at school.
  - All campers are assigned a counselor and should check in with them before leaving their group for any reason including restroom usage.
  - Cell phones are allowed, but we ask that students keep them in their cases during rehearsal. We cannot be held responsible for any lost or damaged electronics.
  - Students who have repeated discipline issues at camp may be asked to return home.
- Communication
  - We will be communicating via email to the address that you provided when you registered.
  - If you would like to receive text messages via "remind" please text @ossc24-1 for last names A-L and @ossc24-2 for last names M-Z to 81010. Both you and your student can subscribe.
- Instruments
  - Everyone must bring their own instruments to camp including cello and bass students. There is a secure place to leave your instrument overnight, should you wish to keep it at camp.
  - Please label your case with your name. There are 200+ campers and all cases look alike. You might also consider putting a small piece of tape on your bow/instrument and labeling it with your name to avoid confusion. We will provide the music for camp; there is no need to bring your strings book
- Special Event Days/Extra Considerations
  - We play some games that involve running so we find that tennis shoes are safer than flip flops.
  - Campers might consider bringing a water bottle (label with your name) everyday as the summer months get hot and we will be outside enjoying the weather. We want to make sure everyone stays healthy and happy.
  - Tuesday is tie-dye day. Please wear appropriate clothing (students may get dye on their clothes).
  - Thursday is Supergames/water games day. Plan to get wet at the end of camp. Please also allow extra time for pickup. Parents might also want to bring a towel for the car ride home or a change of clothing if you have plans after camp.

- All camp activities are subject to change based on weather conditions.

## ADDITIONAL CONTENTS OF THIS PACKET

In the packet you will find the following forms:

- **Emergency medical forms** to be filled out and turned in on the first day of camp. The waiver form for our camp is on the back. Please sign all sections that apply to your child.
- **A Campus Map** with locations marked (on the back of this page). Use the addresses provided on page 1 of the welcome letter for GPS directions
- **A receipt with tax ID info** for those who have already paid will be at the bottom of this letter.
- **Overnight information sheet** only included for those students who will be staying overnight.
- **Prescription and Non-Prescription medicine forms** only needed if medicine needs to be administered at camp or your child will self-carry over the counter medication (Advil, Benadryl, etc).
- **Payment letter** for those who may have outstanding payments.
- **Carpool list** will be emailed to those who requested it. Let me know if you wanted to be included but were left off and I can email it to you.
